## **Ohio 4-H Club/Affiliate Yearly Financial Summary**

**Due January 31, 2019**

All 4-H clubs and affiliates (committees) are required to submit a Yearly Financial Summary by January 31<sup>st</sup>. Club financials will now be reported based on each calendar year's bank transactions, January 1<sup>st</sup> - December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Clubs may elect to complete the form in two ways. 1) Submit the Financial Summary online using the instructions accompanying the summary. 2) Submit the Financial Summary in hard copy form to the Extension Office. The Extension Office will then submit all club summaries to the State Office as required. Each club's Organizational Advisor should have received the necessary information and forms that were included in the Annual Update packet. Additional copies are available on the website or by contacting the Extension Office.
