

Geauga County 4-H Photography Contest 2023

Requirements:

- 1. All images are to be original images taken by the 4-H member.
- 2. Photos must be taken during the 2023 program year and convey a 4-H message.
- 3. All entries are to consist of:
 - a. One 8"x10" framed photograph
 - b. Picture frame must include a means of hanging (wire or hook on backside) and frame will not be judged
 - c. Pictures may be mounted vertically or horizontally
 - d. Member label must be placed in lower right-hand corner of frame (use label provided).
- 4. No computer-generated edits.
- 5. Be sure to obtain the proper permission of subjects being photographed.
- 6. All entries must be submitted to the Extension Office by 4:30pm on August 4th.
- 7. 4-H member entering contest are not required to take a photography project.
- 8. Winners will be announced, and all eligible entries will be displayed in the Jr. Fair Building during fair.
- 9. Youth may enter in more than one division.

Judging Criteria:

Entries will be judged on quality and message. The picture might depict:

- 4-H project work
- 4-H exhibits, shows, clinics, etc.
- 4-H leadership/citizenship
- 4-H education, camp, etc.

Age Categories

A. Cloverbuds - 5-8 years old

B. Jr. Ages – 4-H members 8 years old and in 3rd grade or 9 years old – 13 years old

C. Sr. Ages – 4-H members 14 – 18 years old

* Ages are 4-H age. as of January 1st of current year.

Divisions

- 1. In-Action Photo depicts action taking place
- 2. Animal/Project Photo is of the members project in a stationary position.
- 3. Scenery Photo contains scenery that is related to project area
