Topic - Record Keeping

Record keeping is an important part of every project and you should be keeping records on your project. You will need to know why records are important to keep and what type of records should be kept. Your club advisor should review your book and sign off on its completion for the 2020 project year.

Topic – Body Parts

Juniors may be asked to identify parts of the wing. Intermediates may be asked to identify parts of the feather.

Topic - Diseases

Seniors may be asked to identify up to 10 poultry diseases and/or parasites.

Topic - Animal Health & Care

Juniors, Intermediates, and Seniors may be asked questions regarding poultry health and care.

Topic – Medication Label

Intermediates and Seniors may be asked questions by reading a medication label.

Topic – Brooder Scenarios

Juniors may be asked to identify various brooder scenarios.

Topic - Feed & Feed Tags

Juniors may be asked to answer questions by reading a feed tag and/or identify common feeds. Intermediates and Seniors may be asked to answer questions by reading a feed tag and/or identity common feeds and additives.
