Topic - Record Keeping

Record keeping is an important part of every project and you should be keeping records on your project. You will need to know why records are important to keep and what type of records should be kept. Your club advisor should review your book and sign off on its completion for the 2020 project year.

Topic – Body Parts

Juniors may be asked to identify 10 parts. Intermediates may be asked to identify 15 parts. Seniors may be asked to identify 20 parts.

Topic - Body Types

Juniors may be asked to identify body types based on a picture.

Topic - Breeds

Juniors may be asked to identify 10 breeds. Intermediates may be asked to identify 15 breeds.

Topic - Skeleton

Senior may be asked to identify 15 parts of the skeleton.

Topic – Diseases

Juniors may be asked to identify 5 diseases from pictures. Intermediates and Seniors may be asked to identify 10 diseases from their picture and/or definition.

Topic – Medication Label

Intermediates and Seniors may be asked questions by reading a medication label.

Topic -Feed Tags

Juniors, Intermediates, and Seniors may be asked to answer questions by reading a feed tag.

Topic - Project Knowledges

All members may be asked general questions about their project. This portion is fill in answer.
