

GEAUGA COUNTY 4-H OUTSTANDING 4-H MEMBER DUE NOVEMBER 1ST

4-H is learning by doing. It is also sharing your knowledge with others and developing leadership. To encourage active participation throughout the 4-H program, the Geauga County 4-H Advisory Committee will select outstanding members to be recognized at the yearly recognition ceremony.

To be eligible for the Outstanding 4-H Member award, a member must exhibit outstanding participation across the 4-H program. This award is to recognize youth who have worked to improve themselves and gain personal growth by learning new skills, gaining new knowledge, and participating in a variety of experiences in 4-H. Members are limited to one Outstanding 4-H Member award per year.

Outstanding 4-H Member is awarded on an individual basis not on a species/project basis.

<u>Submission</u>

- 1. Club advisors and program leaders may nominate individuals who meet criteria
- 2. Nominees should have evidence of personal growth and accomplishment during 4-H participation.
- 3. Nominees should have evidence of communication, citizenship, and/or leadership in 4-H projects, local club, county, or state level 4-H events and community participation.
- 4. Form must be completed in its entirety and submitted to the Extension Office by November 1st at 4:30 p.m. in order for nominees to be considered for this award. One nominee per form.
- 5. Club must have submitted yearly officer books for members/volunteers to be eligible for any award.
- 6. Club must be in good standing for members/volunteers to be eligible for any award.
- 7. Cloverbuds are not eligible for Outstanding 4-H Member Award.
- 8. Emphasis should focus on 4-H participation, not Jr. Fair participation.
