Guidelines: Academic Scholarship



The Geauga County Master Gardeners of The Ohio State University Extension is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to **Geauga County residents** who are committed to or who are currently attending The Ohio State University or The Ohio State University Agricultural Technical Institute in Wooster, OH.

Eligibility:

1. High school seniors and residents of Geauga County, who have been accepted to OSU (Columbus), or OSU's Agricultural Technical Institute in Wooster and who plan to pursue a degree in horticulture, agriculture, environmental science or a closely related field
2. Current OSU/ATI students and residents of Geauga County who are pursuing a degree in horticulture, agriculture, environmental science or a closely related field

Requirements:

1. Academic Scholarship Application - available at...

2. Academic reference letter
3. Interview with the scholarship committee for scholarship finalists

Scholarship Details:

1. Scholarships may be renewable in successive years. Recipients would be required to re-apply
2. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application after the scholarship committee has reviewed all submissions
3. Scholarships are for tuition only and distributed via voucher through The Ohio State University
4. Except for emergencies, illness or military service, scholarship recipients are expected to complete their full school year term or forfeit the entire value of the scholarship for that academic year.
